





Begin with the white side facing up. Fold in half, side-to-side, Unfold.




Fold in half, sideto-side, in the other direction.

The completed step, with image enlarged. Make a squash fold on the top of each side, by inserting your finger into the flap to open it, and pushing down on the top.






5 Fold the bottom of the top flap up to where the shaded side of the paper begins.




Fold the folded edge of the top flap up, so that it covers part of the shaded region.




Fold the right and left sides in, on existing creases, to meet at the center.




Lift both sides so that they stand upright from the surface, making the model three-dimensional.
