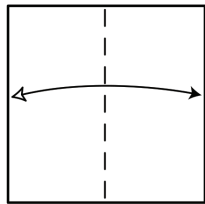
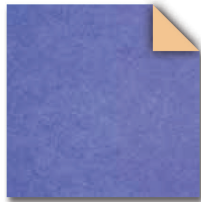
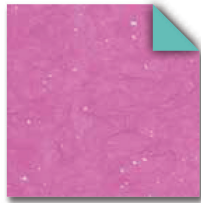


# SIX-POINTED STAR

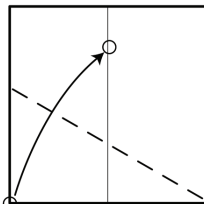

A superb example of origami geometry and human design skills. The final locking move is a little tricky, but just be gentle with the paper, and you'll get it.

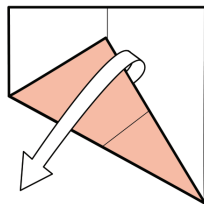
THIS REQUIRES  
6 SHEETS OF  
ORIGAMI PAPER



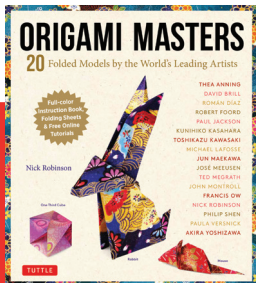
**1** With the unpatterned side facing up, fold in half side to side and unfold.



**2** Fold from the bottom right corner so the lower left corner touches the vertical crease.



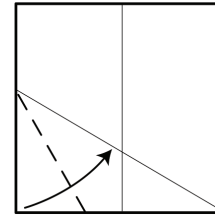
**3** The result, forming a 60 degree angle. Unfold the flap.



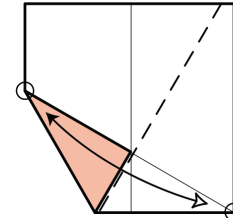

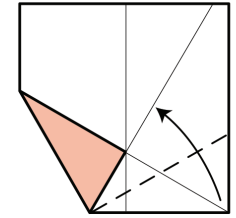
## COMPLEX LEVEL



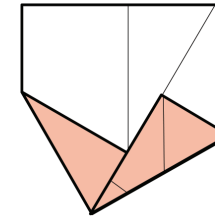
**4** Fold so the lower-left edge lies along the crease you made in step 2.



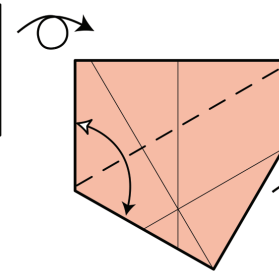
**5** Fold so the circled points meet, crease and unfold.



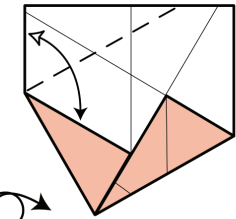
**6** Fold so the lower edge lies along the crease you made in step 5.



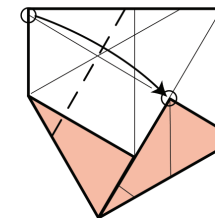
**7** The result. Turn the paper over.



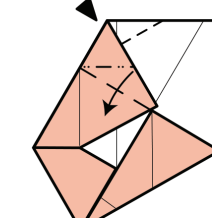
**8** Fold edge to edge, crease, unfold and turn back over. (The crease will not meet the corner.)



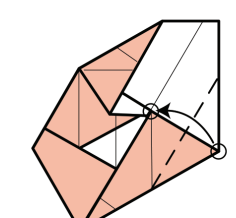
**9** Fold the left edge to the inner shaded edge, crease and unfold.



**10** Fold so the outer end of the crease meets the circled point.



**11** Make the two valley folds, flattening the paper to form the mountain fold.



**12** Fold so the circled points meet.

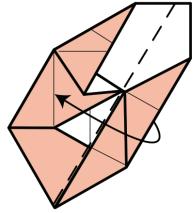

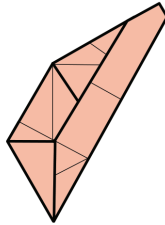

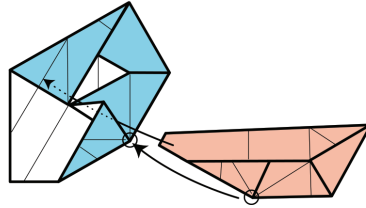
# COMPLEX LEVEL



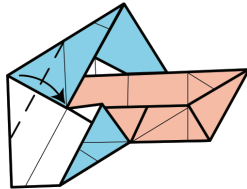
**13** Fold the right flap over.



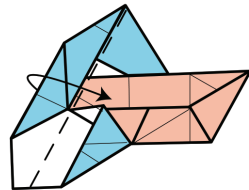
**14** The unit is complete. Make five more, two each of three different colors.



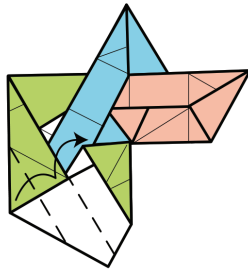
**15** Take a second unit and unfold to step 12. Slide the orange unit under a flap of the blue unit, so the circled corners meet.



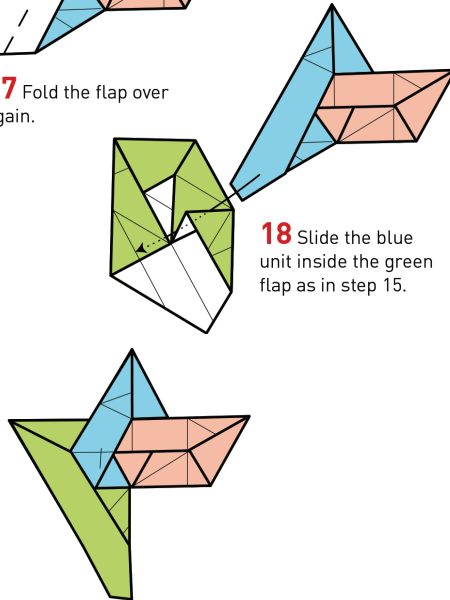
**16** Fold a flap inward.



**17** Fold the flap over again.

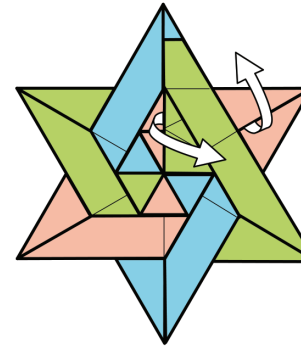


**19** Fold over twice to lock the unit in place.

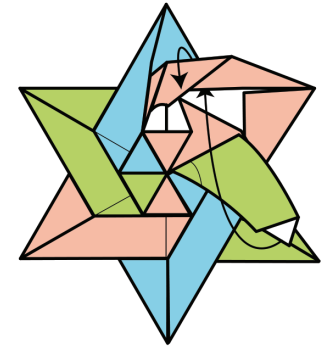


**18** Slide the blue unit inside the green flap as in step 15.

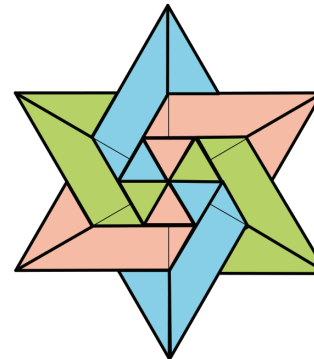
**20** Continue adding units.



**21** When the final unit is in place, partially (and carefully!) open up the first and last units.



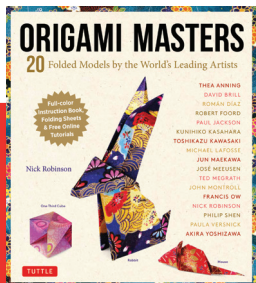
**22** Tuck the green unit inside the orange as with previous points. Finally, refold the first unit flat and tidy everything up.
