Eriko Sato is Associate Professor of Japanese and Japanese linguistics and the Director of the Pre-College Japanese Program and the Teacher Certification Program for Japanese at the State University of New York at Stony Brook. She is the author of many Japanese language texts including the *Learning Japanese Kanji Practice Book* series, *Reading and Writing Japanese* and *Japanese Stories for Language Learners*.

Anna Sato is the co-author and illustrator of *Japanese Folktales for Language Learners* and *My First Japanese Kanji Book*. She is also the illustrator for *Reading & Writing Japanese*.

Vivian Ling was a professor of Chinese language and literature for over four decades. She taught at Oberlin College and Indiana University, and directed various Chinese language studyabroad programs in Taipei, Shanghai, Kunming and Beijing. She is the author of many Chinese language learning books including *The Field of Chinese Language Education in the U.S.* Vivian has co-authored four books with Wang Peng: *Chinese Stories for Language Learners, Essential Chinese Grammar, Bilingual Treasury of Chinese Folktales* and *The Twelve Animals of the Chinese Zodiac*.

Wang Peng has been on the faculty at Georgetown University since 2002, teaching various Chinese language courses including Business Chinese and Chinese for Heritage Learners. She was formerly the Chief Instructor at the Inter-University Program for Chinese Language Studies at Tsinghua University, as well as a visiting faculty at Oberlin College and Brown University.



Yoshie Ishibashi is a researcher and the co-translator of *Chiyo-jo's Haiku Seasons* and *The Classic Tradition of Haiku*, among other works.

Natalie Goldberg is the author of 16 books, including *Writing Down the Bones* and, most recently, *Writing on Empty* and *Three Simple Lines: A Writer's Pilgrimage into the Heart* and *Homeland of Haiku* which includes haiku by Chiyo-ni.



Pantun Baba Chan is a collection of 100 original pantun poems written in Baba Malay over a period of 15 years by Chan Eng Thai, a prominent member of Singapore's vibrant Peranakan community. Chan's poetry celebrates the traditions of his community and a nostalgia for the old ways—ranging from favorite foods to rites of passage to commemorations of famous people. The book includes a hilarious pantun "duel" between the author and G.T. Lye over WhatsApp.

The pantun is an oral poetic form with a rich tradition dating back centuries. Written in Baba Malay, a Creole tongue merging Malay with Hokkien Chinese, these poems express complex emotions in quatrains with an ABAB rhyming scheme. They were extremely popular in prewar Singapore and Malaysia but are now considered a dying art, although a revival is currently underway.

This book is a labor of love—the first collection of Baba Malay pantuns published since the early 1900s and the first to present parallel English and Baba Malay versions of the poems. Baba Chan hopes that putting his words to paper in this way will inspire others to follow suit and preserve the language and traditions of the Peranakan Chinese community.


Chan Eng Thai speaks Baba Malay as his mother tongue. Born and raised in Geylang in Singapore, he shares his deep knowledge of Peranakan Chinese culture through programs at the Peranakan Museum, the NUS Baba House and Singapore's Peranakan Association. He is a practicing lawyer, known by some to dish out a decent nasi ulam. This is his first book.

G.T. Lye is a Wayang Peranakan actor/playwright and pantun composer/performer. He started his career in Felix Chia's Pileh Menantu. The play was a landmark in Peranakan Chinese theater which sparked a revival in Singapore. He became a household name for his hilarious rendition of a crossdressing Peranakan matriarch in many subsequent stage and screen performances. In 2020, G.T. was recognised as a Steward of Singapore's Intangible Cultural Heritage by the National Heritage Board for his mastery in the art forms of Wayang Peranakan and Dondang Sayang.



Frequent stays there gave her the opportunity to adopt new perspectives. She learned from Japanese masters the "art of the line" as well as the mysteries of *haiga*, compositions where painted images and calligraphy come from the same brush, forming an integrated whole. She has published many books of *haiga* illustrations and poems in her native France, notably on the works of Basho and Santoka.



He was sent to London by the Japanese government in 1900 on the first English literary scholarship, where he developed a love for Shakespeare and Dickens. Returning to take up a position at Tokyo University, he began his writing career with *I Am a Cat, Botchan* and *Kokoro*. He is the only Japanese author referred to by his personal name (Sōseki) rather than his family name (Natsume) and his image appears on the Japanese 1,000 yen note.

Erik Lofgren is Professor of East Asian Studies at Bucknell University where he teaches classes on Japanese language, literature and film. He has published several works on the poetry of Umezaki Haruo, on the fiction of Furui Yoshikichi and Ooka Shohei, and the films *Rashomon* and *Shin Gojira*.





He was awarded the Noma Prize for literary translation and the Japanese government's Order of the Rising Sun.

J. Keith Vincent teaches Japanese literature at Boston University, where he also directs the MFA Program in Literary Translation. His translations include *A Riot of Goldfish* by Kanoko Okamoto, *Devils in Daylight* by Junichirō Tanizaki, and Sōseki's novel *Michikusa*, forthcoming from Tuttle.



Osamu Dazai (1909-1948) is the pen name of Shuji Tsushima, who first attracted attention in 1933 when magazines began to publish his work. Between 1930 and 1937, he made three suicide attempts, a subject he deals with in many of his short stories. Despite his troubled life and rebellious spirit, Dazai wrote in a simple and colloquial style, conveying his personal torments through his writings. Dazai's life ended early in a double suicide with a married lover.

Juliet Winters Carpenter studied Japanese literature at the Inter-University Center for Japanese Language Studies in Tokyo and the University of Michigan. After completing her studies, she returned to Japan where she became a translator and teacher. She is professor emeritus at Doshisha Women's College of Liberal Arts in Kyoto and has received numerous awards for her translation work including the William F. 

Osamu Dazai (1909-1948) was the pen name of Shuji Tsushima, the tenth of eleven children born to a wealthy landowner and politician in the far north of Japan. Dazai studied French literature at the University of Tokyo, but never received a degree. He first attracted attention in 1933 when magazines began to publish his work. Between 1930 and 1937, he made three suicide attempts, a subject he deals with in many of his short stories. Despite his troubled life and rebellious spirit, Dazai wrote in a simple and colloquial style, conveying his personal torments through literature. Dazai's life ended early in a double suicide with a married lover.

James O'Brien is Professor Emeritus at the University of Wisconsin-Madison and has published several translations of both modern Japanese fiction and poetry. His most notable work is the short story collection *Crackling Mountain and Other Stories* by Osamu Dazai. He has also published modern translations of poetry by Hagiwara Sakutaro, Kitahara Hakushu, Miyoshi Tatsuji, Takamura Kotaro, and Murano Shiro, and modern tanka by Yosano Akiko.

Kojiki is the classic of Japanese classics—a foundational text for Japanese history and for the Shinto religion. This literary masterpiece has shaped Japanese thought and culture for a millennium. Ō no Yasumaro was a prominent Japanese nobleman and scholar of the Nara period. He worked under the imperial court's commission to compile the *Kojiki* and collaborated closely with Hieda no Are, who recited to him the oral traditions that formed the basis of the text. Yasumaro's work has been crucial in preserving Japan's early culture, identity and spiritual heritage.

Basil Hall Chamberlain (1850-1935) was a British Japanologist who played a key role in introducing Japanese culture and language to the West.

Matthieu Felt received his Ph.D. in Japanese literature from Columbia University. He is the author of *Meanings of Antiquity: Myth Interpretation in Premodern Japan*.







One night, lost in the dark, the samurai calls out to the kitsune for help and is guided safely home.

Naoshi Koriyama taught at Toyo University in Tokyo, where he is now Professor Emeritus. He is the translator of *Like Underground Water: The Poetry of Mid-Twentieth Century Japan* and numerous other books of verse.

Bruce Allen is Professor in the Department of English Language and Literature at Seisen University in Tokyo. He has translated several works of the Japanese writer Ishimure Michiko, including her novel *Lake of Heaven*.

Karen Thornber is Harry Tuchman Levin Professor in Literature and Professor of East Asian Languages and Civilizations at Harvard University. Her books include *Gender Justice* (2024), *Global Healing* (2020), *Ecoambiguity* (2012), and *Empire of Texts in Motion* (2009).



Yei Theodora Ozaki was born in Victorian England to a Japanese father and an English mother. After her parents' marriage ended, Ozaki began to travel the world, and to retell in English the traditional Japanese stories she loved. She later married Yukio Ozaki, a Japanese politician, and went on to publish several collections of Japanese folk tales.

Sakyu is an illustrator based in Osaka whose work frequently depicts yokai and other supernatural beings. Blending traditional styles with modern content, she brings humorous insights to life in Japan. Her work has appeared in museums in Japan and abroad, including the Museum of International Folk Art exhibit "Yokai: Ghosts & Demons of Japan" and the video game *Samurai Bringer*.

Zen and the Beat Way

By Alan Watts

When Jack Kerouac wrote his novel *Dharma Bums*, his views on Zen Buddhism echoed the sentiments of the Beat Generation, who found in Zen a way of life unencumbered by the limitations of "square" society. And it was the philosopher Alan Watts who first spoke about Zen in terms that were accessible to mainstream Western audiences. Watts was an engaging speaker and an icon of America's Counterculture movement who named among his friends Aldous Huxley, Lawrence Ferlinghetti, John Cage and Joseph Campbell.

Through his popular series of radio talks, *Way Beyond* the West, Alan Watts presented the practical side of Zen,

which he described as "a cure for education and culture." By the early sixties, his radio programs were renowned for their synthesis of Eastern wisdom and everyday life. This book is an engaging introduction to Watts' enduring teachings. The fascinating essays in this collection include:

- *The Beat Way of Life*—How the Beats lived an uncomplicated Zen life and despite being denigrated as worthless slackers, like Eastern thinkers they actively pursued "an arduous course of spiritual and psychological discipline"
- Return to the Forest—How the popular works of the writer Joseph Campbell influenced the earliest Beat traditions by advocating an internal search for individual truth over learned schools of thought
- *The Democratization of Buddhism*—How Buddhism is actually a "religion of no-religion" that conveys the spiritual through the everyday and the ordinary, and recognizes no division between the two

Watts' teachings—delivered during an era of turmoil and political strife—are as timely today as they were half a century ago.

Alan Watts was a former Episcopal priest, born in London in 1915. He came to the U.S. in the 1930s, where he became a scholar of Eastern religions. He moved to San Francisco in 1951 where he began teaching Buddhist studies and in 1956 began his popular radio show, *Way Beyond the West.* By the early 1960s, his radio talks aired nationally and the Counterculture movement adopted him as it's spiritual spokesman. He went on to write more than twenty books. He died in 1973.

- A Year of Shards—Back in Japan to study ceramics, McArthur is aghast to learn that her brother, who also has leukemia, has relapsed. At the same time, her master's thesis strategy falls apart, and she must regroup.
- Recollections of a Curator—McArthur shares her trials and triumphs as a Japanese art curator, relating the meaning of wonderful artifacts like a samurai sword, Buddhist prints, folk paintings, bronze dragons and woodblock prints.
- Spotted Pumpkins and Origami—McArthur deepens her appreciation of modern Japanese art during a stay on the "art island" of Naoshima, home to several giant pumpkin sculptures by Yayoi Kusama. She also coordinates traveling exhibitions of origami masterpieces and assists with an exhibition of the work of Shinkai Makoto, a major Japanese animation artist.

This book provides avid art lovers with new ways of seeing and appreciating the power of art.

Meher McArthur has decades of experience as an Asian art historian and curator specializing in Japanese art. With degrees from Cambridge University and London University's School of Oriental and African Studies (SOAS), she has served as Curator of East Asian Art at Pacific Asia Museum, Creative Director for the Storrier Stearns Japanese Garden, Academic Curator for Scripps College and Art and Cultural Director for Japan House in Los Angeles. She teaches courses in Asian art and regularly lectures and trains docents at various museums. For over a decade, McArthur has curated exhibitions for International Arts & Artists (IA&A).

Pico lyer is a British-born essayist and novelist who was educated at Eton, Oxford and Harvard. He has been living in Western Japan since 1987. He is the author of 15 books, and has been a constant contributor for more than 30 years to *Time, The New York Times, Harper's Magazine,* the *Los Angeles Times* and more than 250 other periodicals worldwide. He has written introductions for more than 50 other books. He speaks regularly everywhere from West Point to Davos and Shanghai to Bogota, and his four recent talks for TED have received more than ten million views.

As one of the most distinguished and gifted Japanese diplomats of his generation, Yukio Okamoto navigated the corridors of power at the highest levels. Okamoto was born in 1945 just two months after Japan surrendered to the Allies. During the war, his father served in the infamous Unit 731, a secret project that committed horrific war crimes. Okamoto was deeply affected by his country's devastation and his family's shame.

During a 20-year career in the Japanese Foreign Ministry and after he left government, Okamoto was an indispensable advisor to several Japanese prime ministers including Ryutaro Hashimoto, Junichiro Koizumi and Shinzo Abe. He worked tirelessly to strengthen relations with the United States even as other government officials advocated for the dismantling of the U.S.-Japan Security Alliance. The survival of this alliance is due in no small part to Okamoto's influence.

This book features contributions from former Deputy Secretary of State Richard L. Armitage and former Assistant Secretary of Defense Joseph S. Nye Jr., who both worked with Okamoto and share their thoughts on his life, career and legacy as an influential friend of the United States.

Yukio Okamoto was a career diplomat in Japan's Ministry of Foreign Affairs from 1968 to 1991 with postings in Paris (OECD), Cairo and Washington. Following his retirement, he became a political and economic consultant. He served as Special Advisor to Prime Ministers Ryutaro Hashimoto and Junichiro Koizumi, sat on the boards of several major Japanese multinationals and served as an advisor to several others. Okamoto joined the Center for International Studies at MIT in 2012 as a Robert E. Wilhelm fellow. He was a well-known commentator and author, publishing regular columns and contributing to major newspapers and magazines on Japanese diplomacy.

Richard L. Armitage is founding partner and President of Armitage International. He served as Deputy Secretary of the Department of State and as the Assistant Secretary for International Security Affairs at the Department of Defense. In addition, he has held a wide variety of high-ranking U.S. diplomatic positions.

Joseph S. Nye, Jr. is Professor Emeritus and former Dean of Harvard's Kennedy School of Government. He has served as Assistant Secretary of Defense for International Security Affairs, Chair of the National Intelligence Council, and Deputy Under Secretary of State. He is a fellow of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences, the British Academy, and the American Academy of Diplomacy. In 2011, Foreign Policy named him one of the top 100 Global Thinkers. In 2014, Japan awarded him the Order of the Rising Sun, its highest civilian honor for a non-Japanese.
